By the 16th Section, 3rd and 4th sub-sections of the Act 22 Victoria, Cap. 13, Consd. This Schedule is to contain the names of every person who abode in the house on the night of Sunday, January the 13th, 1861—whether the same be settled of Canada,—and also every person usually resident, but then casually absent, distinguishing such persons from others.
