RESIDENCE AND PERSONAL DESCRIPTION. Name of each person in family, household or institution. Place of habitation. Relationship to head of family or household. Sex. Relationship to head of family or household. Month of birth. Year of birth. Age at last birthday.

CITIZENSHIP, NATIONALITY AND RELIGION. Country or place of birth. Year of immigration. Year of naturalization. Racial or tribal origin. Nationality. Religion.

PROFESSION, OCCUPATION, TRADE OR MEANS OF LIVING. Chief occupation or trade. Employment other than as chief occupation or trade. Employer. Employee.

WAGE-EARNERS. State where person is employed. Weeks employed in 1910. Hours of working time per week. Wages received in 1910.

INSURANCE HELD AT DATE. Type of insurance. Amount of insurance.

EDUCATION AND LANGUAGE OF EACH PERSON FIVE YEARS OF AGE AND OVER. Months at school in 1910. Can read. Can write. Language commonly spoken.

INFIRMITY. Blind. Deaf. Dumb. Paralyzed. Other.
