The Order of the Knights of Labor was, in many ways, the most important labour union in North America during the nineteenth century. In Canada it flourished during the early 1880's, when more than 400 Local Assemblies were established in cities and town from Halifax to Nanaimo. However, the Order was strongest in the most industrialized provinces of Ontario and Quebec and all but two of the eighteen District Assemblies formed in Canada were located in Central Canada. As occurred in the United States, the Knights declined rapidly in Canada after 1887 although it remained a substantial force in many centres until well into the first decade of the twentieth century. The main reason for the success of the Order was its all-inclusive philogophy and industrial form of organization which embraced unskilled workers and women as well as craftsmen. Not only an economic tool for its members, the Knights of Labor was a movement of considerable political, social and cultural significance in late Victorian Canada.

Hayes, Secretary-Treasurer of the Order between 1888 and 1902 and subsequently General Master Workman. The original documents are in the custody of the Catholic University of Washington and this microfilm copy was prepared by the Microfilming Corporation of America. The MCA Guide provides both a general introduction to the history of the Knights of Labor and a detailed description of the contents of the papers. There is a great deal of documentation pertaining to Canada in these papers, mainly in the form of letters to Powderly from members of the Order in Canada and his replies. This material reveals not only the internal history of the Knights in Canada but also much about the society in general and working class life in particular. The index prepared by Russell Hann lists most of these items by name of correspondent, date, place and local or district assembly numbers (where applicable).

PART IV

A. INTRODUCTION

This index has been prepared to assist the student of Canadian history to use the Powderly and Hayes Papers. Until now the material pertaining to Canada has been largely inaccessible because it was interfiled with the far greater quantity of American documentation. To find anything, the researcher had to examine the whole body of material. While a few Canadian items may have been missed in the preparation of this index, it is not likely that anything of importance has been overlooked. Still, the index should be used as a starting point in exploring the Powderly and Hayes Papers.

An understanding of the basic organization of the two sets of papers is useful to anyone using the microfilm. For the most part, the Powderly Papers have been maintained the way that Powderly left them. Fortunately, Powderly was meticulous about his correspondence and it is relatively easy to find particular items when one understands the system. When Powderly received a letter, he stamped it with the date of receipt. On answering the letter, he stamped it with the date of his answer. The letter was then filed according to the original date of the correspondence. Undated material was usually filed at the end of the year in question, by date of receipt. There are irritating lapses in this system on the microfilm: some material was filmed out of sequence and some was misfiled prior to micro-filming. However, for the most part the arrangement is consistent.

Powderly kept copies of his answers in letter press copy books. Each book has numbered pages and an alphabetical index to the correspondents at the front of each book. Powderly generally also referred to the date of the correspondence he was answering in his response. Unfortunately, for several years he maintained more than one letter book at the same time, so there is no easy matching chronological system to the letter books and the incoming correspondence. In some instances, Powderly appears to have sent his incoming correspondence to other individuals for their reactions and these copies seem to have been lost. Towards the end of his life, Powderly also checked through his letterbooks to sanitize that which he did not feel fit for posterity. Offensive pages were ripped out of the letterbooks and destroyed. Unfortunately, some Canadian material was destroyed in this way.

The Powderly correspondence is particularly rich. In the early 1880s after 1887, Powderly increasingly gave work that he had done earlier to the General Secretary-Treasurer and the staff of the international headquarters in Philadelphia. However, even after the mid-1880s Powderly was still the last resort of the Local Assembly and there is a considerable amount of material from the 'rank and file' of the Knights in Canada as well as from the leadership. Throughout his tenure as General Master Workman, Powderly lived in Scranton, and his written communication with headquarters in Philadelphia helped to produce a rich documentary source.

PART IV - Introduction (cont'd)

The Hayes Papers are not as extensive as the Powderly Papers and constitute a selection of what was judged to be significant correspondence at some point in time. The correspondence which has survived is in much poorer condition than that in the Powderly Papers; the majority of the Hayes Papers at Catholic University were so badly watermarked that they were not even microfilmed and what has been microfilmed is often difficult to decipher. The Hayes Papers were arranged in a number of different series by Catholic University. There are three main series of correspondence: (1) a portion of Hayes' general correspondence relating to the Knights of Labor which includes Powderly's letters to Hayes between 1880 and 1890 (arranged chronologically), Hayes correspondence as General Master Workman after 1902 (arranged alphabetically), and Hayes' correspondence as General Secretary-Treasurer between 1888 and 1902 (arranged alphabetically); (2) the correspondence of Hayes and a few others with Local Assemblies between 1888 and 1904: (arranged in order of the Local Assembly number); and (3) the correspondence of Hayes and others with District Assemblies between 1892 and 1906 (arranged in order of the District Assembly number). Unfortunate lapses in the various organization systems make it difficult to locate some of the Canadian material; however, most of it is reasonably easy to find. The bulk of the material in the Hayes' Papers relates to the Knights of Labor under Powderly as General Master Workman. The Local and District Assembly correspondence which has survived tends to be that from Assemblies which continued to report to the international headquarters into the 1890s. The records of assemblies which lapsed before the 1890s did not survive which is unfortunate because these are the Assemblies of most interest to the student of the Knights.

Some warning should be given regarding the arrangement and the condition of the documents on the microfilm. Microfilming Corporation of America was unable to convince the Catholic University to allow any reorganization of the papers prior to microfilming. Unfortunately, as noted above there is some improper and inconsistent arrangement. Some of the letters to Powderly, written in various kinds of pencil and ink, are not very legible. The correspondence in the letterbooks is easily read. However, the Hayes correspondence, with incoming and outgoing correspondence interfiled, is particularly hard to decipher. Early in the microfilming process the frame counter seems to have malfunctioned and eventually it was abandoned. This makes it difficult to give the location of material which is out of order.

The criteria for inclusion in this index were very broad. The correspondence of Powderly and Hayes with Canadian Knights in particular Local and District Assemblies is straightforward: every such piece of correspondence found has been included. All material written from Canada by non-Knights during the Knights of Labor period also has been included. In the latter sections of the Powderly Papers there is correspondence with American immigration officers in Canada relating to immigration policy which has not been included because it relates in only the most peripheral way to the Knights and to Canada. Every letter written from Canada by American Knights of Labor organizers and lecturers has been indexed. Some correspondence by Americans relating to Canadian affairs was discovered and included. The letters of international executive members were surveyed for Canadian content in a general way and some material was discovered. Some material was also discovered in the letters of particular American correspondents who dealt with Canadian affairs in one way or another.

PART IV - Introduction (cont'd)

However, no systematic survey of this material could be made. Thus the researcher may use the index as a key to the discovery of further material of this kind.

During the Knights of Labor period Powderly became a close correspondent with two Canadians--the Liberal trade unionist D.J. O'Donoghue and the Tory labour reformer A.W. Wright. Some explanation of the selection made from this material is necessary. The O'Donoghue correspondence is extensive and relates to many aspects of Canadian labor in Toronto and throughout Canada during the period. All the correspondence between him and Powderly that was found has been included. Powderly's correspondence with A.W. Wright begins later and Wright gradually replaces O'Donoghue as Powderly's chief Canadian confidant by the late 1880s. The Wright correspondence presented some problems in deciding what to include. Wright became a Lecturer in the Order in 1888 and later a member of the General Executive Board of the Knights. He spent a great deal of his time in the U.S. performing these functions and in mid-1889 he moved to Philadelphia to become editor of the Journal of the Knights of Labor. His correspondence is more voluminous than that of D.J. O'Donoghue. A selection of it was made in order to exclude the vast amount of material which describes his duties relating to purely American matters. However, because Wright is a pivotal figure as far as the Canadian Knights' experience is concerned, purely American material which describes A.W. Wright in important ways has been included. Furthermore, because the demise of T.V. Powderly in late 1893 as General Master Workman is also closely tied up with many of the schemes of A.W. Wright, such as the Labor Day Annual and the Accident Claims Association, a great deal of this material has been included as well. The correspondence of Tom O'Reilly, a member of the Journal staff at headquarters and a close friend of Powderly, was examined and many of his letters complaining about Wright's work habits have been indexed. O'Reilly also provides documentary evidence about the contributions of another Canadian, Phillips Thompson, to the Journal of the Knights of Labor. Because the Hayes Papers are less extensive, there are no comparable figures in the correspondence. Hayes' principal Canadian associates were Isaac Sanderson of Toronto and Richard Kerrigan of Montreal and everything that they wrote has been included. Another Canadian, John S. McClelland of St. Catharines, was also a member of the international executive in the early 1880s; however, his major experience in labour organization appears to have been in the U.S. and his correspondence relating to Canada is small. Another close friend of Powderly, the American John Devlin from Detroit, was the U.S. consul at Windsor in the mid-1880s. His extensive correspondence with Powderly was surveyed. Relatively little of it has been included in the index because he appears to have taken almost no part in Canadian Knights of Labor Affairs.

B. POWDERLY PAPERS - Incoming Correspondence

Most of Powderly's correspondence is filed by the date of the letter. The small number of undated letters was filed at the end of the particular year in which it was received in order of Powderly's stamp of receipt. Any diversion from this system is noted on the cards.

In the latter years of his correspondence, Powderly often included copies of his own answers along with the incoming correspondence he filed. This has been noted on each particular card as clearly as possible.

An index of correspondence, arranged in the order in which it appears on the microfilm, has been prepared. For each piece of correspondence, the following information is noted (when applicable): its place of origin, date, the number of the Local or District Assembly from which it originates or to which it relates, and the date of the answer as stamped on the item. For items obscurely or incorrectly filed, a brief locational note is included.
